**Questions for you to consider in deciding if being part of Unit 10 works for you:**

- Do you live within 15 minutes from either SAR Vessel? (Steveston Harbour. Middle Arm Fraser)
- Can you commit one hour, one or two evenings a week + 3 hours of training on weekends. (This is on average every 3<sup>rd</sup> weekend BUT can be changed as staffing and needs are dynamic)
- Does your lifestyle allow you to be paged out at any hour, any day to respond to marine emergencies?
- Can you commit to a minimum of one year, active duty?
- Are you a self-starter and take initiative?
- Do you want to challenge yourself and make a difference in the lives of others?

If you answer yes to all these questions, submit your application. An interview will be arranged.
